Our Organization

Dogs and Cats of the Dominican Republic (DCDR) was founded by a group of volunteers to reach out to the impoverished Dominican and Haitian communities in the Dominican Republic. Our main goals are to improve the health and welfare of their pets, provide ongoing care to free-roaming street and beach dogs, and to ensure loving care of the animals via our education programs. Through our Community Outreach Program, monthly parasite medications are provided, first-aid is administered, and both dogs and cats are spayed and neutered as opportunity arises.

In our efforts to reach even more poor communities, we purchased an old bus and transformed it into our wonderful Rescue Rover. The Rescue Rover is a self-sufficient mobile surgical unit that has already played host to several vets from the Dominican Republic, Canada, the United States and even Europe.

Everyone involved is a dedicated volunteer.

We Need You

Dogs and Cats of the Dominican Republic needs volunteer veterinarians who can spay and neuter dogs and cats for the Dominican and Haitian people who could never afford the costs of veterinary care, and in many cases do not even have access to it. These animals are pulled from our Community Outreach areas where they have been treated for parasites, and monitored on a monthly basis. Post surgery, our dedicated volunteers continue to observe the animals and ensure their well-being.
